

Annual Report 2009 - 2010



The Foundation launched its official website www.kangayambull.com on 15 January 2009 at its office in Kuttapalayam, Kangayam Taluk, Erode District by Shri.Sivasenapathy saminathan, Chairman of the foundation. The website contains details about the Kangayam cattle breed, Korangadu, the silvi-pastoral traditional land use pattern that is the backbone of the Kangayam breed, about the history of the Kangayam breed, maintenance of Kangayam bulls, breeding details, morphmetric details of the Kangayam breed. There is also a comparison between bas indicus and bas Taurus.

On 7 April 45 teachers from Vivekalaya Matriculation School, Coimbatore along with the principal and secretary visited the foundation and the farm. They gained first hand knowledge on breeding of Kangayam cattle, use of cattle waste as inputs in agriculture, compost making and organic farming.

On 20 April 2009 Shri.Anbu Sundaranadal Swamigal of Earth Trust, Coimbatore and Ooty visited our foundation and farm staying two days to gain an improved understanding about Kangayam Breed and explained organic farming techniques to a group of farmers.

Keepers for Conservation of Livestock Resources at the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences (NAAS), New Delhi. The group had an opportunity to interact with a large number of government officials, non-governmental organization working on Animal Genetic Resources (AGR) and its Rights. During 24-27 November 2009 a group of 50 farmers from Tumkur, Karnataka headed by Dr.Nagaraja, Joint Director of Animal Husbandry, Government of Karnataka, Dr.M.Rajashekar, Assistant Director, Veterinary Hospital, Dr.H.R.Nanjundappa, Assistant Director, Veterinary Hospital, Dr.Hamappa, Assistant Director, Veterinary Hospital, visited the kuttappalayam farm to learn about the Kangayam Breed, Korangadu and use of cow dung and cow urine in agriculture.

On the 6th of February 2010, Our foundation organised a grand "Kangayam Cattle Show" under the

side lines of "Nam Tirupur Koodal 2010". The prize money for seven categorizes was sponsored by Tamil Maiyam, Chennai. The event was first of its kind and had a tremendous response from livestock keepers, breeders and the general public. The show was inaugurated by poet Kanimozhi, Member of Parliament and was felicitated by Ministers from the Government of Tamilnadu Mr. Pongalur N. Palanisami, Minister for Animal husbandary, Mr. Saminathan, Minister for Highways, Mr. Suresh Rajan, Minister for Tourism, Mr.

where she could learn about the ancient local system of "Aachi Madu" in Kongu region.lt is a system where a lady is given a "Kangayam Cow" as gift by her parents after her delivery.The heifers of the said cow are continuously kept

within the family for years together. There is a lot of sentiment attached to the cow and is given preferential treatment, love and care. Dr. Ilse was immensely pleased to see the fourth generation of the cow given by the parents of Mrs. Thilagavathy Jegadesan whose daughter is now 22 years old. Her daughter assured Dr. ilse that she would take with her the "Aachi Madu". It is customary that the cow or heifer of the mother goes to the daughter in the family.

The documentation of Mr.Vivekanandhan a passionate livestock keeper of the same village for the natural service provided by his bull for the past 15 years astonished the visitors. He also mentioned that after the "Kangayam Cattle Show 2010" conducted by this foundation there has been 3 fold increase for his bulls natural service as his was awarded the 2 nd prize in the young bulls category.



Dr. Ilse was fascinated by Mrs. Soundaram Ramaswamy, locally known in her village Punjai Thaliyur,near Mulanoor, as the "Bull Lady" who rears 5 nos of bulls for livelihood. It was a wonderful sight to watch the bulls running towards her like children after she whistled for

them. Later Dr.llse and team visited the "Sankarandampalayam Kaavidi" a bio cultural event linked intrinsically with the "Kongu Nadu" where people carrying pots of water to the lord Muruga Temple in Palani walk with their 'Kangayam Bulls" and bullock carts. It is a religous event which cannot be conducted without the "Kangayam Cattle" at its helm.
